

Grading Parameters TRADEREX GHANA LIMITED GRADING STANDARDS FOR MAIZE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE GHANA COMMODITY EXCHANGE

- An adjustment of 1.5% is made to the weight of the grain to make provision for losses during the handling and storage process.
- Maize is free from foreign odours.
- Maize is free from glass, coal, dung or metal
- White maize = $\min \text{ of } 98\%$ white kernels
- Yellow maize = min of 98% yellow kernels
- Total Defective Grains include the sum of pest damage, discoloured, immature/shrivelled and rotten and disease grains.
- The sampling and grading is done using a work sample of at least 200 gram.
